Crime Insight version 3.5.1 was released on June 4, 2024.

Repository and Reporting

The following issues have been addressed in this release:

All states	SUP-1101	Corrected the issue where sometimes a user was getting prompted twice for their credentials when accessing the repository site.
All states	SUP-1100	Ensured that a user is correctly taken to the Initial Page that is set from the Role Management page.
All states	CI-2531	In addition to allowing victim injuries for offenses 09A and 09B, the same is now done for 09C - Justifiable Homicide.
All states	CI-2530	The error description for error 220 on the NIBRS Upload Details page has had "Gang Information" added to it. I.e. "Type of Criminal Activity/Gang Information must be entered for Offense x".
All states	CI-2515	We now load and display population for agencies who are Not Reporting but who have reported population from the FBI.
All states	CI-2498	Changed the label for bias 28 to "Anti-Church of Jesus Christ" in the Incident Editor, reports and cubes.
All states	CI-2496	Error 178 generalized to read, "178 - Record length does not meet requirements as documented in the state's Technical Specification".
All states	CI-2484	The Audit log now tracks when Tasks are paused or started.
All states	CI-2469	Help text for error 173 improved slightly.
All states	CI-2464	The four hierarchies from the Incident Offenses dimension in the Incidents cube have been made into separate dimensions, replacing the existing Incident Offenses dimension, and the Offense Type hierarchy is now the same one used in all other cubes.
All states	CI-2459	Infrastructure has been put in place to map 11B and 11C to 11A, when the time comes.
All states	CI-2428	Incidents with offenses that are internally marked as inactive are rejected on ingestion/validation.
All states	VA-426	Ensured that when sending to the FBI via their web service, the injury code for each victim is mapped to the correct FBI code.
All UoF* states	CI-2517	Removed 11X All Rapes from the Offenses dropdown in the Use of Force Editor since it's not a valid offense.
All UoF states	CI-2475	The list of offenses that appears in the Use of Force editor when Initial Contact is "Response to unlawful or suspicious activity" and the number of offenses is greater than 0, is sensitive to whether 11B and 11C are currently active.

All UoF states	CI-2466	Fixed an issue where corrected errors were still being shown on the Use of Force Single Incident Viewer report.
All states with Summary reporting	SUP-1091	Corrected the H2 yyyy values in the "SRS Offenses Known to Police" RS report.
All states with Summary reporting	SUP-1060	Added protective logic to NIBRS-to-Summary conversion to handle data previously corrupted by bad agency submissions.
All states with Summary reporting	CI-2535	Now converting the new relationship codes to an existing value for Summary Homicide reporting.
VA	VA-460	Added new state-specific drug types.
VA	VA-458	Ensured that on the Community Policing Data Upload page, only those errors and warnings for ORIs that the user has access to are shown.
VA, ND	CI-2513	On the Agency Dashboard, when clicking on a link to one of the other pages (View Upload History, View Details, Notices, etc), there is no attempt to pass the selected agency to the destination page. This is a temporary measure until we've implemented our new approach for remembering selected agencies across pages.
VA, ND	CI-2500	Corrected an issue with the Agency Dashboard's NIBRS/UoF counts of outstanding errors/warnings when the preference was set to hide older errors/warnings.
VA. CO	CI-2497	Corrected an issue with the "is not" logic in a filter criterion.
СО	SUP-1088	Ensured that uploading a Contacts file only shows one status line.
СТ	CT-270	Within the Census Tract dimension in Perspective, the Planning Region selection button tooltip has been changed to read, "Select Planning Region".
