

Crime Insight Release Notes v4.1.2

Crime Insight version 4.1.2 was released on March 20, 2026.

What's New?

The primary purpose of this release is to support the MO project for more detailed reporting on incident clearances. The project also includes MO getting a new XML specification (IEPD) to support the FBI's 2025 changes.

MO Reporting on Incident Clearance

As part of a new project, the MO cubes have been extended to support additional analysis on incident clearance. The key changes include:

- Adding a new dimension for Clearance Date, to allow reporting by when clearances were achieved, as opposed to when incidents took place
- Adding a new measure for Average Days to Clear, to allow analysis on the time taken for each agency to clear different types of crimes, victim demographics, etc.
- Adding a new measure to the Arrestee and All Arrestee cubes to count the number of crimes cleared by each arrest.

In addition to the updates to the cubes, this release includes a new report summarizing data on clearances achieved during a specific time frame, breaking down the types of clearances, types of arrests, and victim demographics.

The project also includes a new TOPS theme on incident clearances (to be delivered later) and a new feature in TOPS. It is now possible to compare results across agencies for any chart in any theme. The new version of TOPS also includes fixes to security issues found in a recent scan in Virginia.

Updates to Support for NIBRS 2025.0

It was recently identified by the FBI that their documentation for errors related to the Criminal Activity Type field had some issues. The most significant issue relates to offense 280 (Stolen Property Offenses) and the values expected/accepted in the Criminal Activity Type field. In version 4.1.2, the logic in Crime Insight has been updated.

It is now the case that error 220 is generated if the Criminal Activity Type field associated with offense 280 does not contain at least one of these values: B, C, D, E, O, P, T, U. Error 219 is generated if the field contains any value other than this list or W.

Bug Fixes - Repository

The following issues have been addressed in this release:
